## OBJECTIVE

The mission of the Certificate in International Veterinary Medicine (CIVM) is to help students make meaningful contributions to the understanding of international veterinary medicine and the inter-relatedness of animal health globally

## REQUIREMENTS

### 1. Proficiency in a foreign language

Students must have language skills at or above the second university course level. If at least two levels of foreign language were completed at a student's undergraduate institution, the student may provide a copy of an unofficial transcript to show documentation. Students can take two courses of IVSA's Spanish Language for Vet Students, if offered. Otherwise, students are encouraged to contact the [University Testing Center](#) to complete a language placement test.

### 2. Attend 4 International Veterinary Medicine Lectures approved by Academic Affairs

### 3. Completion of 5 Livestock Lessons

Lessons are completed on livestock.org. Lesson #3 and Lesson #8 are required and the remaining three lessons are elective.

### 4. Completion of an international externship of at least 3 weeks duration

### 5. Completion of a Special Project under the guidance of a faculty mentor

### 6. Create a presentation (PPT, Canva, etc.) of your experience
