To detect BVD persistently infected animals. Collect ear notch samples into individually labeled capped tubes; ship with ice packs overnight to the lab. This test is validated for cattle only; for alpacas and other exotic species, please request PCR test.

Reason for testing (ie. surveillance, weaning, known positive in herd, death, etc.)

Submission implies agreement with GVDL testing/billing procedures and policies. Specimens may be referred to other reputable laboratories and applicable shipping fees/test charges added to the client's bill. A clerical handling surcharge will be applied for leaking formalin, if a fixed sample is too large for removal from container, or if a needle is received. Samples submitted for testing become the property of the Georgia Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratories.
